### Datblygiad Creadigol Creative Development

- Ourselves – collage/painting faces for a wall display.
- My name - making and decorating name-plates.
- My family – drawing and describing family members.
- Environmental art, based on work by Welsh artist Tim Pugh.
- Autumn art and craft activities.
- Bonfire Night crafts – rockets and fireworks.
- Christmas crafts – Christmas cards and decorations.
- Music – syllable claps, rhythm and body percussion, learning/singing a range of songs in English and Welsh.

### Datblygiad yr Iaith Gymraeg Developing the Welsh Language

- Lliwiau/Colours

- Ardaloedd y dosbarth, iaith Amser Enfys / Areas of the classroom, language for Rainbow Time.

### Datblygiad Corfforol Physical Development

- Chwarae i Ddysgu/Play to Learn – developing physical skills using stories – Megan and the Baby Dragon.
- Two PE sessions a week, following the Physical Literacy Scheme (Unit 1, Sessions 1 and 2).
- Activities in the outdoor area, nature area and allotment to develop gross motor skills.
- Activities in all areas to develop fine motor skills.
- Outdoor PE Sessions
- Yoga

### Datblygiad Personol a Chymdeithasol, Lles ac Amrywiaeth Ddiwylliannol Personal and Social Development, Well-being and Cultural Diversity

- Ourselves – what is important to us? One Page Profiles.
- Amser Enfys – weekly session, working with a partner, to develop interaction and co-operation.
- Circle Time – discuss school rules, talk about feelings, Learning Powers.
- Elmer's Story - acknowledging the similarities and differences between ourselves and others.
- Our families – talk about important people in our lives.
- Being a good friend – share our ideas.
- Christmas around the World – looking at how people in different countries celebrate.

### Datblygiad Mathemategol Mathematical Development

- Maths on the Mat – whole class sessions using songs, number rhymes, visual resources and games to develop number skills and mathematical reasoning.
- Games and practical activities to develop number recognition, sequencing and counting skills.
- Learning to write the numbers to 10 - multi-sensory activities to encourage correct number formation.
- Beginning to record maths activities - lots of opportunities to practice number formation.
- Copying and making simple repeating patterns.
- Introducing simple addition – practical activities.
- Learning days of the week and months of the year (birthday month), sequencing daily events (Welsh and English).
- Recognizing and naming common 2-D shapes, making pictures using shapes.
- Using Numeracy skills in all areas (indoor and outdoor).

### Iaith, Llythrennedd a Chyfathrebu Language, Literacy and Communication

- Jolly Phonics Sessions – introducing the single letter sounds. Learn the action, and how to form each letter correctly. Focus on blending sounds to read and build words as soon as the first 6 letters have been taught. Take Sound Books home to practice.
- Weekly Narrative Sessions – focusing on confidence and clarity of speech – asking and answering questions.
- Activities to develop pencil control and correct letter formation – using paint, finger paints, felt pens, pencils
- Letter recognition and letter formation practice using the Jolly Phonics resources and ipads.
- Activities and games to develop awareness of initial letter sounds, moving on to CVC words as children are ready.
- Learning to write our names correctly.
- Talking about ourselves, our families and friends. 'Talking Partners', describing, drawing, sharing information.
- Write and Draw – beginning to write in a conventional way – 'writing' about ourselves, our families, our homes, our friends, our news, People Who Help Us in School, The Christmas Story, Letter to Father Christmas.
- Making a class information book about 'People Who Help Us in the Community'.

### Gwybodaeth a Dealltwriaeth o'r Byd Knowledge and Understanding of the World

- Finding our way - familiarize with school surroundings – making and using a simple map.
- Talking about where we live/our homes. Local walk.
- When we were babies/look how we've grown-storyboards.
- Our bodies, parts of the body, the skeleton, our senses.
- Learning the names of the seasons. Autumn activities.
- Finding out about People Who Help Us – school staff, lollipop man, doctor, paramedic, police, fire service, lifeboat, postman. Arrange visitors to school – think of questions to ask.

### Addysg Grefyddol Religious Education

- Learn the lunchtime and home time prayers.
- Harvest – Thanks Giving
- Stories with a message – caring for others, friendship.
- The Christmas Story – sharing, discussing and re-telling the story of the first Christmas.
