Datblygiad Creadigol Creative Development

- Music – Listen to and learn Under the Sea 'Little Mermaid song, learn '1,2, 3, 4, 5 once I caught a fish alive', 'Fuooh chi 'rioed yn morio'
- Painting, drawing, collage, clay modelling and wall art displays – recreating pictures of characters from the book 'Commotion in the Ocean' by Giles Aandreae and David Wojtowycz.
- Under the Sea messy play area.
- Creative dancing – (See physical development for further information).

Datblygiad yr Iaith Gymraeg/ Welsh Language Development

- Geirfa – Y tywydd, tymhorau / Vocabulary – The weather, seasons.
- Rhannu storiâu / sharing stories – amrywiaeth o chwedlau gwahanol yn gael ei gyflwyno yn Gymraeg ac yn Saesneg.
- Caneuon/rhigymau am y tywydd – songs and rhymes about the weather.
- Gwers Cymraeg yn cael ei gyflwyno gan Miss Griffiths. Gweler cynlluniau Cymraeg.
- Patrymau newydd – 'Ga i ...', 'Dwi'n hoffi/ddim yn hoffi...' / New phrases – 'Can I ...', 'I like/don't like...'

Datblygiad Corfforol Physical Development

- Physical Literacy Sessions twice a week – Unit 1 – developing movement skills, using balls and small apparatus, gymnastics and dance.
- Creative Dance – listen to and create moves to go with the music From 'The Carnival of the Animals – Aquarium' by Saint-Saëns.

Datblygiad Personol a Chymdeithasol, Lles ac Amrywiaeth Ddiwylliannol Personal and Social Development, Well-Being and Cultural Diversity

- Amser Enfys – weekly session, playing/working with a partner - to encourage interaction, co-operation and independent selection of activities.
- The Rainbow fish: book about a beautiful fish who finds friendship and happiness when he learns to share. Teach morals about the value of being an individual and for the distinctive shiny foil scales of the Rainbow Fish.

Under the Sea / Summer 2021 O Dan y Mor / Tymor yr Haf

Datblygiad Mathemateg Mathematical Development

- Maths on the Mat: whole class sessions using games, visual resources and rhymes to develop number skills and mathematical reasoning.
- Number activities and focus tasks using Numicon.
- Learn to recognise, name and sequence numbers to 5, 10 or 20 according to readiness.
- Learn to count small groups of objects accurately, and match the correct numeral.
- Games and activities which encourage children to recognise, name and sort 2D shapes.
- Learn to match objects, and sort objects into groups using 1 or 2 criteria.
- Develop mathematical vocabulary to describe size and position (comparing size in Goldilocks story).
- Continue to use Numicon in circle time, continue to use Numicon at the seaside.

Iaith, Llythrennedd a Chyfathrebu Language Literacy and Communication

- Continue to develop listening skills through mat sessions, games and focus tasks.
- Continue to learn to write name independently, forming letters correctly.
- Begin to recognise initial letter sounds (sound of the week)
- Narrative Sessions – focusing on confidence and clarity of speech – asking and answering questions and describing events (Who? Where? When?)
- Listening to a range of fiction and non-fiction books connected to 'Under the Sea' including 'Commotion in the Ocean' and 'Rainbow Fish'.
- Draw and write – begin to draw pictures (my news, fairy tale characters). Describe, and overwrite words/labels.
- Sharing stories and information books about the spring.

Gwybodaeth a Dealltwriaeth o'r Byd Knowledge and Understanding of the World

- Discuss what we know about the Summer season, seasons and the weather? What do we know about the sea? What would you like to learn about the sea?
- Discuss sea pollution – how can we keep the sea clean?
- Discuss recycling
- Planting seeds and flowers and watch them grow.
